INTRODUCTION

Select the Scholarships you wish to apply for:

The Exploring Scholarship: One \$1,000 scholarship, active Explorer in Northern Star Council.

Allan G Lee Scholarship: Two \$1,000 scholarship, active Law Enforcement Explorer in Northern Star Council.

Major Mahipathi Scholarship: One \$1,000 scholarship, active Law Enforcement Explorer in Northern Star Council.

Willie Lee Bjorge Scholarship: One \$1,000 scholarship, active Explorer in Northern Star Council.

*The recipients are selected from a pool of eligible high school seniors and above who are presently involved in Exploring and who submit this application by March 1, 2026. Scholarship winners are selected by a volunteer committee of community leaders, and selection is based upon the criteria (noted in their information packets). The scholarships may be applied to tuition and books at the college, junior college, vocational college or trade school of the winner's choice. Application forms, along with all additional materials we request, must be completed in full and included for an applicant to be considered (incomplete applications will not be considered).

GENERAL SELECTION CRITERIA

The youth who are chosen for the scholarships:

- Be a high school senior preparing to enter a college, junior college, or vocational school in the fall of 2025 or be currently enrolled in a college, junior college, or vocational school in the fall of 2025.
- Currently registered in the Exploring program, Northern Star Council, with a minimum of one year participation in Exploring.
- Have demonstrated an interest in career exploration through participating in the Exploring Program.
- Had demonstrated leadership ability in Exploring and a strong record of participation in school or community activities.

INSTRUCTION CHECKLIST

When filling out the application form, we recommend that you:

- Read the entire application form first.
- Type or print in black ink.

Besides the application below, please include the following:

- Letter of Recommendation---Ask an adult member of your Exploring post to write a personal letter of recommendation. This letter of recommendation must be included with your completed application form. We encourage you to include letters of recommendation from other sources.
- High School or College Transcript--You will need to include your high school transcript that covers six semesters. If you are college- or junior college-bound, you will also need to include SAT or ACT test scores.
- Essay—Write a brief essay (no more than 1 page) that responds to the following statement: The Exploring program has been important for me and this is why. Your signature on this statement confirms that the essay is written in your own words.
- This is a dated application form.
