

# **EXPL**⊗RING<sup>™</sup> 2020 Exploring Scholarship

# INTRODUCTION

The Exploring Scholarship program offers one \$1,000 scholarship to an active Explorer in Northern Star Council. The recipient is selected from a pool of eligible high school seniors and above who are presently involved in Exploring and who submit this application.

The Scholarship winner is selected by a volunteer committee of community leaders, and selection is based upon the criteria noted below. The scholarship may be applied to tuition and books at the college, junior college, vocational college or trade school of the winner's choice. Application forms, along with all additional materials we request, must be completed in full and included for an applicant to be considered (incomplete applications will not be considered).

### SELECTION CRITERIA

The youth who is chosen to receive the \$1,000 scholarship:

- Be a high school senior preparing to enter a college, junior college, or vocational school in the fall of 2020 or be currently enrolled in a college, junior college, or vocational school in the fall of 2020.
- Currently registered in the Exploring program, Northern Star Council, with a minimum of one year participation in Exploring.
- Have demonstrated an interest in career exploration through participating in the Exploring Program.
- Had demonstrated leadership ability in Exploring and a strong record of participation in school or community activities.

### INSTRUCTION CHECKLIST

When filling out the application form, we recommend that you:

- Read the entire application form first.
- Type or print in black ink.

Besides the application below, please include the following:

- Letter of Recommendation---Ask an adult member of your Exploring post to write a personal letter of recommendation. This letter of recommendation must be included with your completed application form. We encourage you to include letters of recommendation from other sources.
- High School or College Transcript--You will need to include your high school transcript that covers six semesters. If you are college- or junior college-bound, you will also need to include SAT or ACT test scores.
- Essay—Write a brief essay (no more than 1 page) that responds to the following statement: The Exploring program has been important for me and this is why. Your signature on this statement confirms that the essay is written in your own words.
- This is a dated application form.
