

## INTRODUCTION

The Major Mahipathi Law Enforcement Exploring Scholarship program offers one, or more, \$1,000 scholarships to active Explorers in Northern Star Scouting involved in Law Enforcement Exploring. The recipient is selected from a pool of eligible applicants who are or were involved in Law Enforcement Exploring.

The Scholarship winner(s) is/are selected by a volunteer committee of Law Enforcement and community leaders, and selection is based upon the criteria noted below. The scholarship(s) may be applied to tuition and books at the college, junior college, vocational/ trade school of the winner's choice. Application forms, along with all additional requested materials, must be completed in full and included for an applicant to be considered.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants **MUST** meet the following criteria:

- *Be a high school senior (in good academic standing) or older preparing to enter a college, junior college, or vocational/trade school in the fall 2022 or be currently enrolled (in good academic standing) in a college, junior college, or vocational/trade school in the fall of 2022.*
  - *Currently or previously registered in the Exploring Program, Northern Star Scouting, with a minimum of one year participation in a Law Enforcement Explorer Post.*
  - *Has demonstrated an interest in a career in Law Enforcement.*
  - *Has demonstrated leadership ability and a strong record of participation in school or community activities.*

The following **MUST** be included with your application.

- **Letter of Recommendation(s)** - *A personal letter of recommendation from an adult member of your Exploring post. Additional letters of recommendation from adults outside of your post are accepted and encouraged.*
- **High School or Higher Education Transcript** - *Your current high school or higher education transcript.*
- **Statement** - *Respond to the following statement via an essay, poem or song (one page maximum). Why is the Exploring program important to me? How are you a good citizen of the world through your actions, deeds, thoughts, or ideas. Express how you would establish a more harmonious community or world.*

**Your signature on the application confirms the statement is written in your own words.**

Completed applications **must be postmarked or received on or before March 1, 2022**. The recipient will be informed of the committee's decision in early April 2022.

The application is the property of the Northern Star Council Scholarship Committee. It will not be returned to the applicant.
